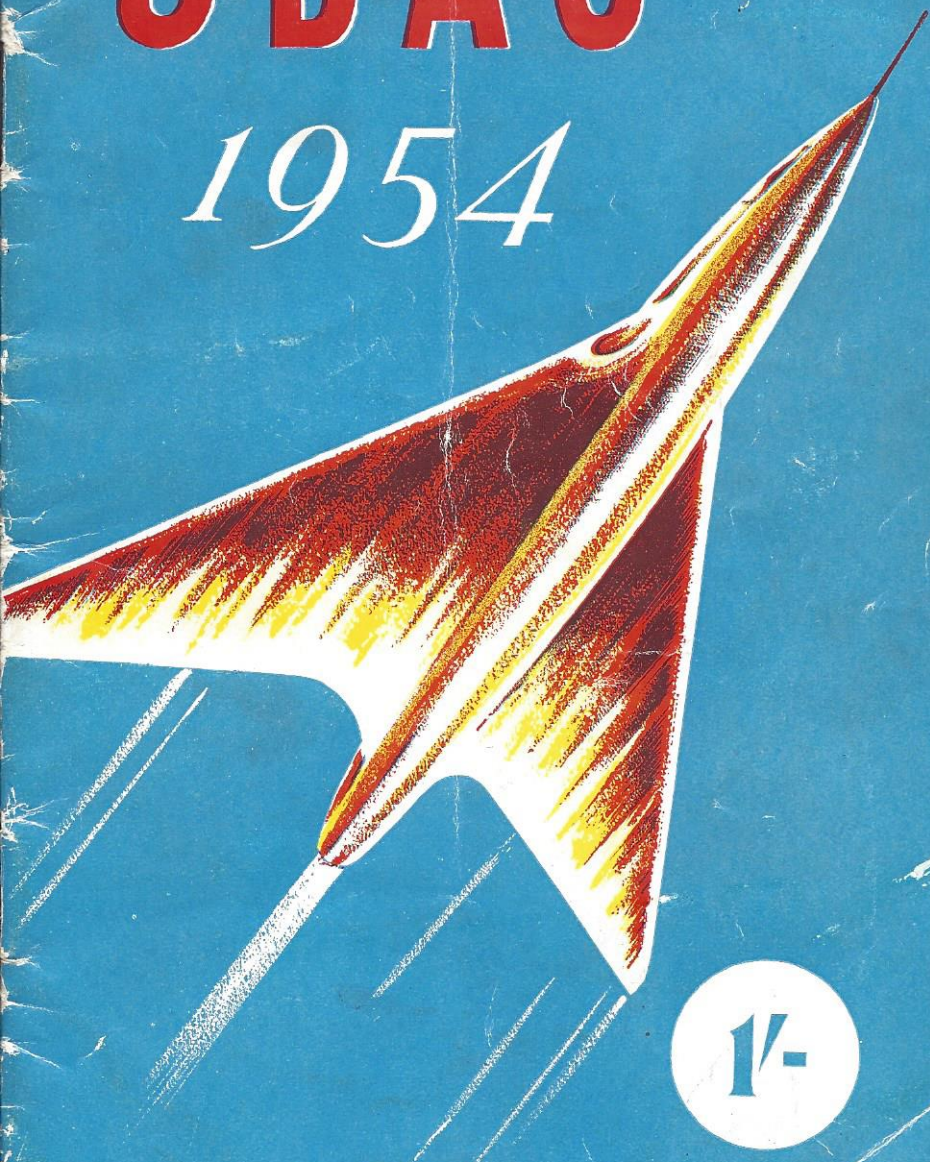

F O R E W O R D

THIS is the Society of British Aircraft Constructors' Fifteenth Flying Display and Exhibition, opened to the public to show the whole range of the industry's products. Many of these aircraft, in service with the R.A.F. and N.A.T.O., will soon bear a large part of the responsibility for the defence of the West, while their civil counterparts will cover the globe in air-line services spanning the five continents.

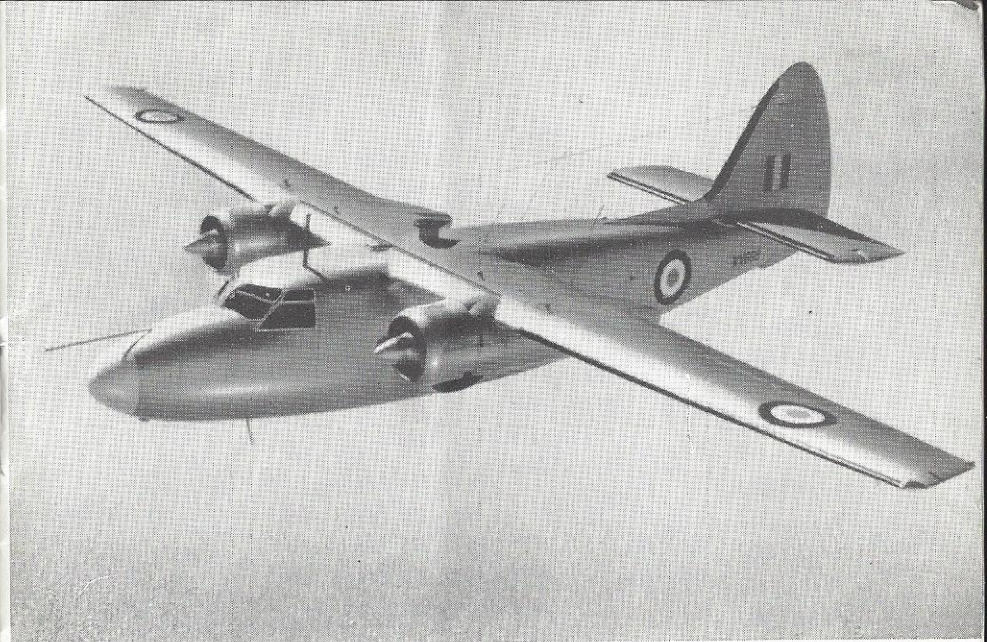
Last year the aircraft industry became the third largest employer in the United Kingdom. This, in peacetime, is surely a remarkable achievement for an industry which was founded little more than forty years ago. In the present international atmosphere it is inevitable that much of the industry's work should be concerned with defence in the form of aircraft or guided missiles, but nevertheless a substantial proportion of output is destined for the civil market. It is significant that such a large part of our civil output is being produced for foreign buyers. Our large gas-turbine aircraft have now been ordered by twenty-six airlines which are owned and operating overseas. The value of these and other aircraft exports in terms of foreign currency represents a major contribution to the present healthy state of Britain's economy.

In the big exhibition tent, you will see for yourselves some of the parts and materials which are necessary for the high performance and safety standards of the aircraft of today. Nearly three hundred firms are exhibiting the innumerable components which go into the jet and turboprop airliners, the jet fighters and bombers, the helicopters and trainers required by the Air Forces and airlines of the world.

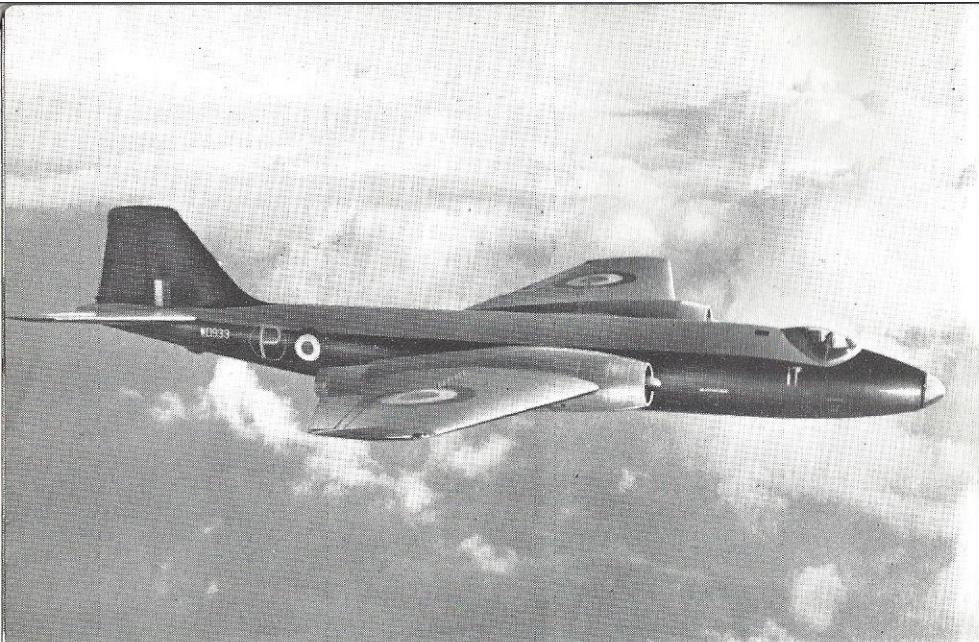

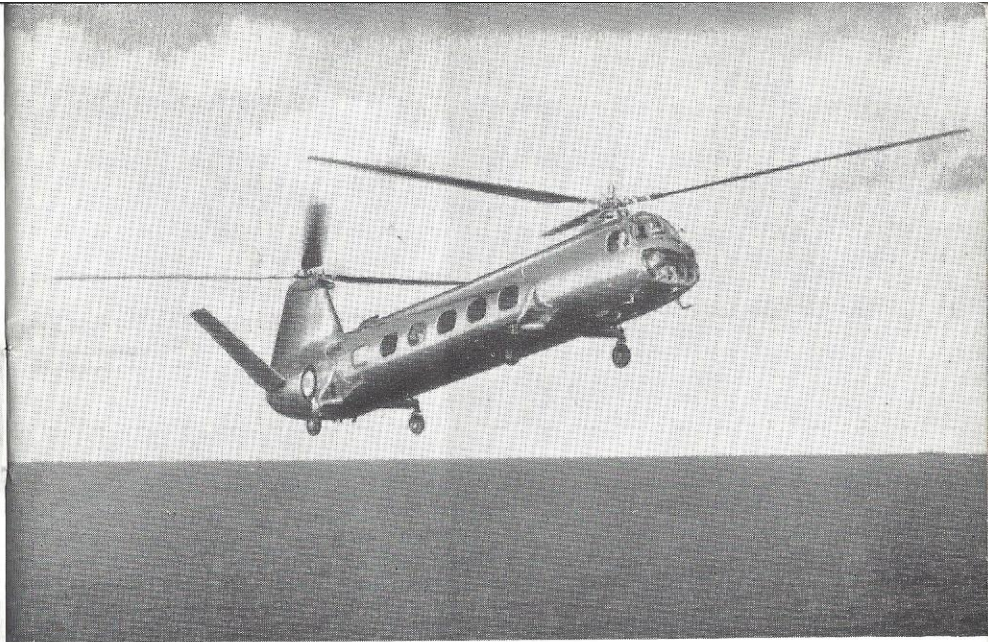

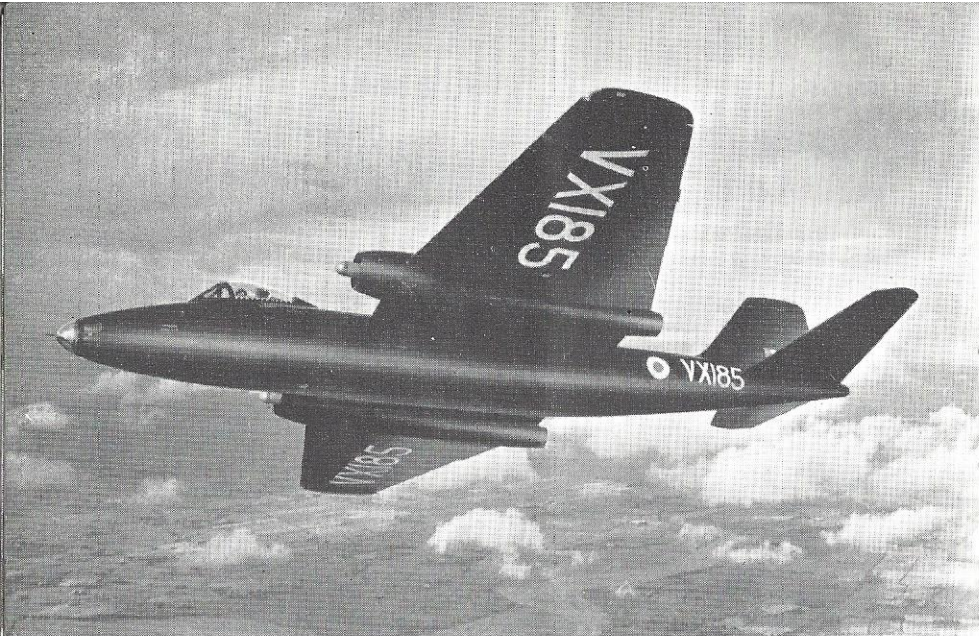


Short Sherpa single-seat aero-isoclinic wing research aircraft powered by two Blackburn-Turbomeca Palas jet engines

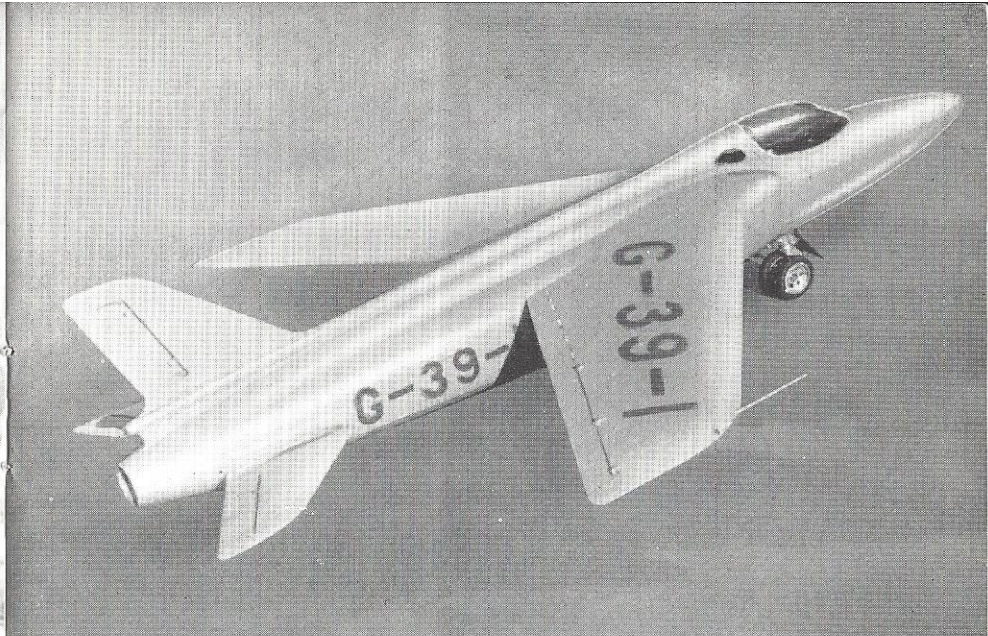
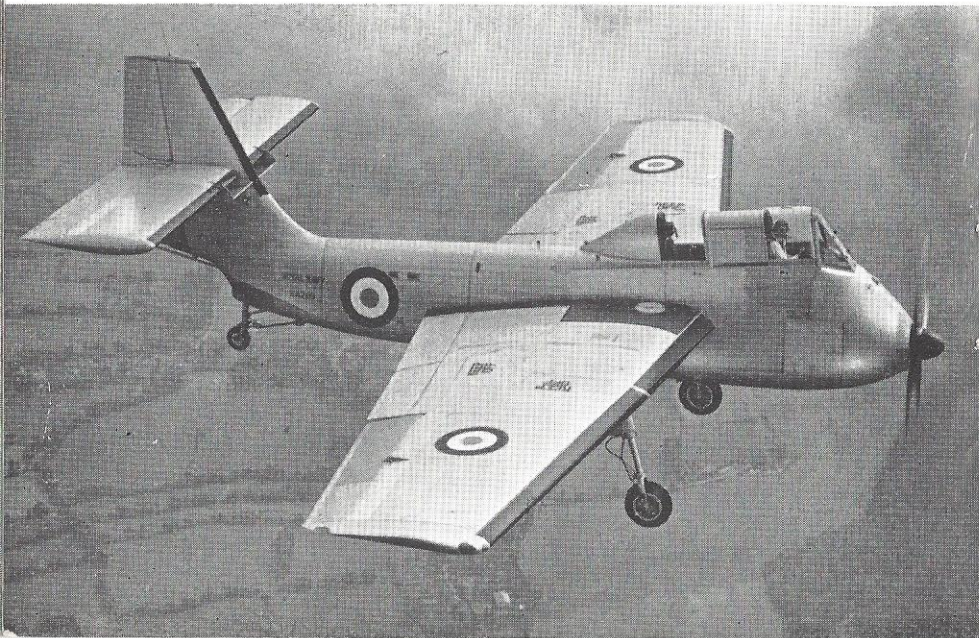




English Electric Canberra B.8 2-seat night intruder version of the Canberra bomber powered by two Rolls-Royce Avon jet engines

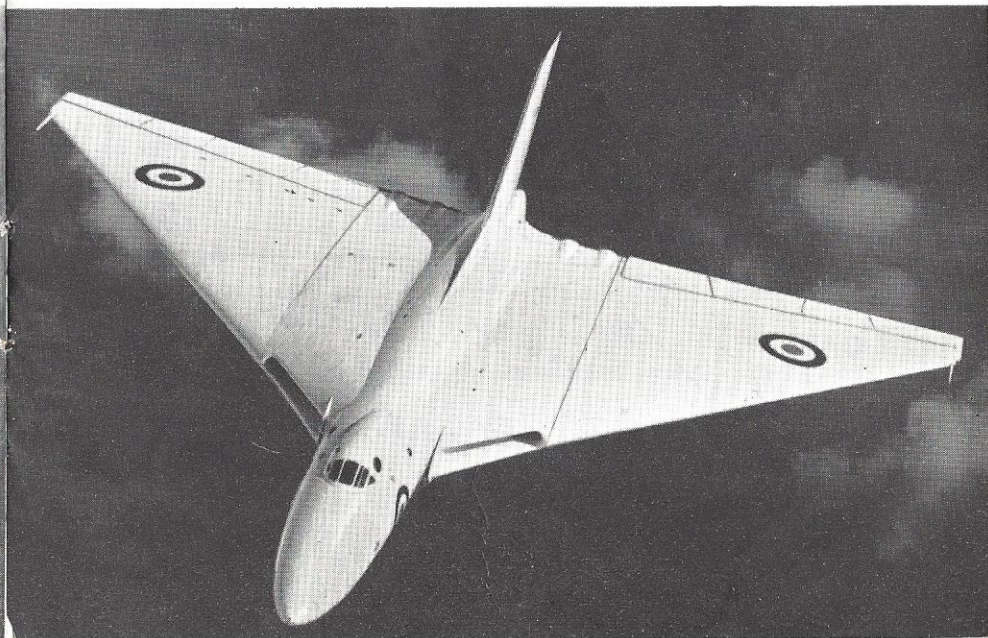

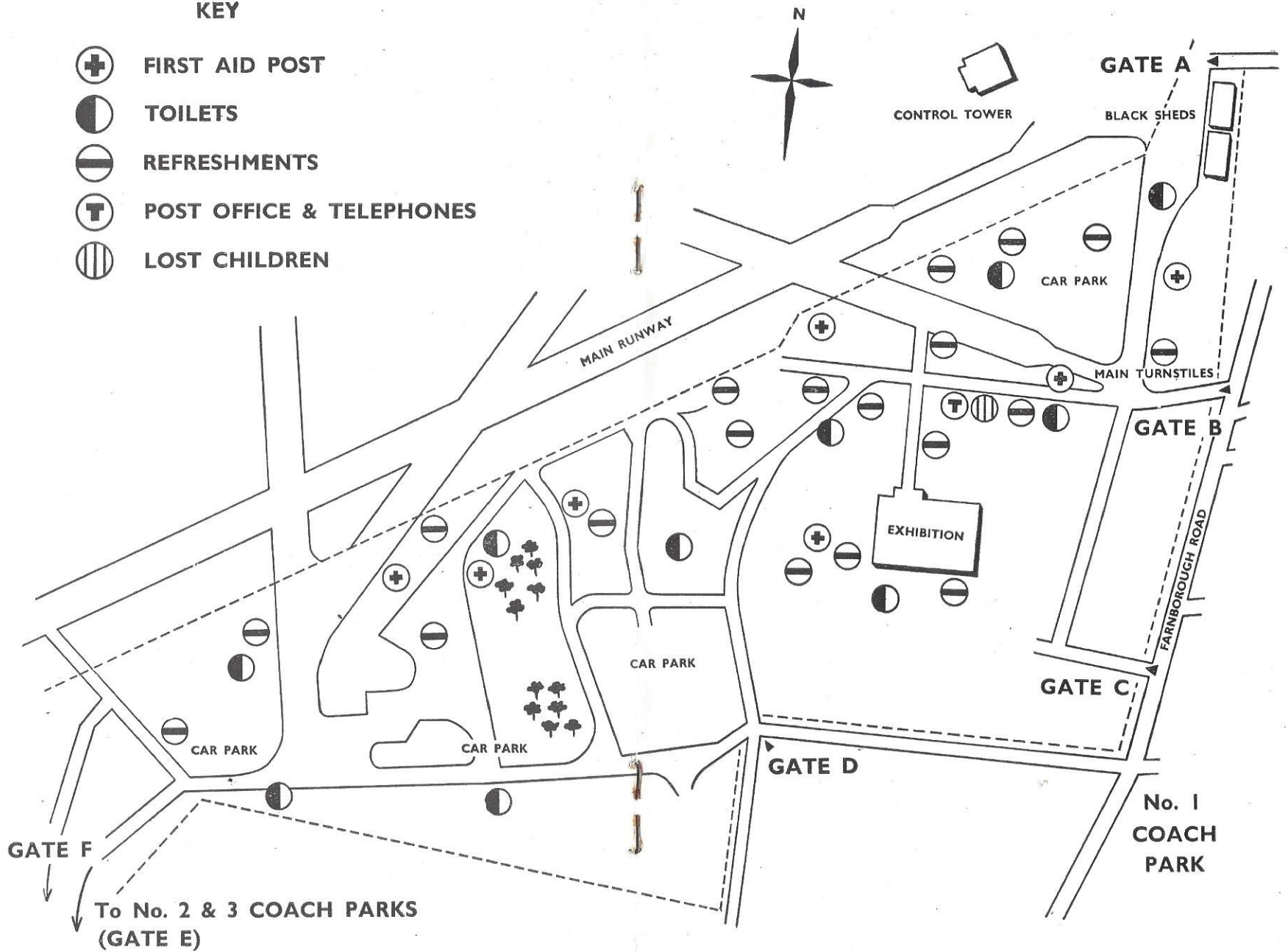

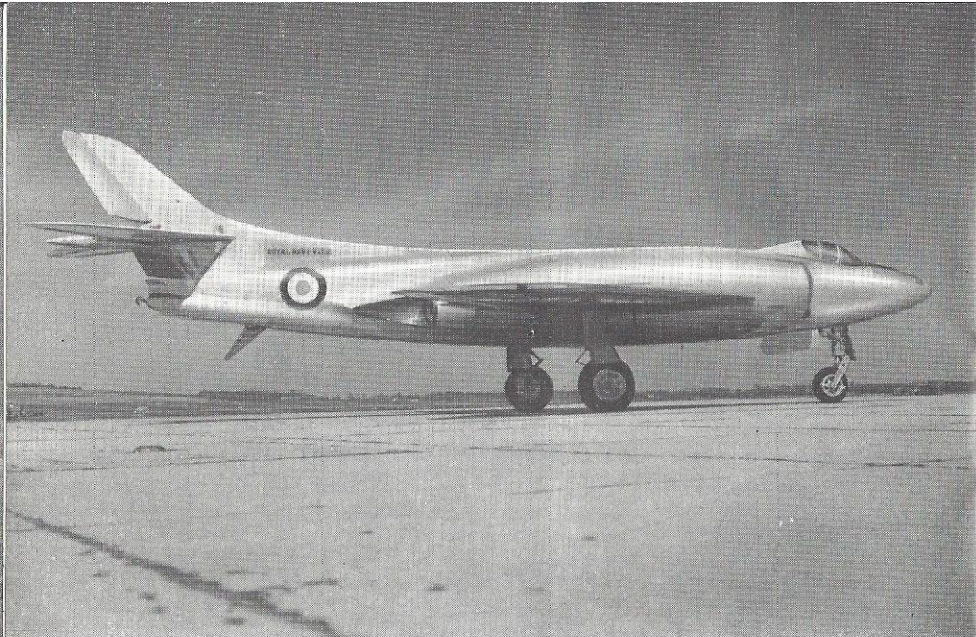
Avro Vulcan bomber powered by four Armstrong Siddeley Sapphire jet engines. The production aircraft has four Bristol Olympus engines

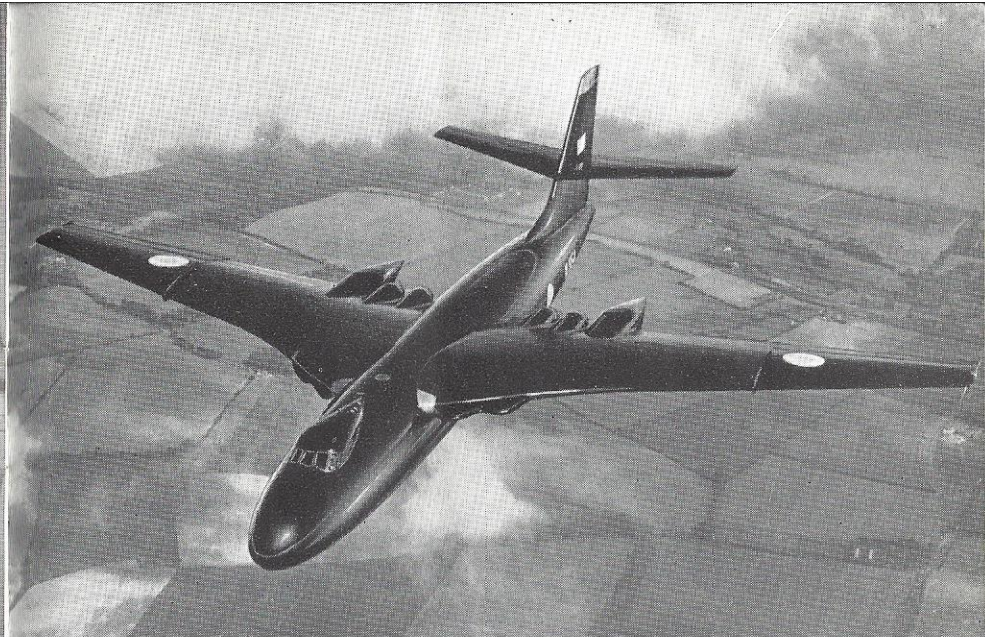
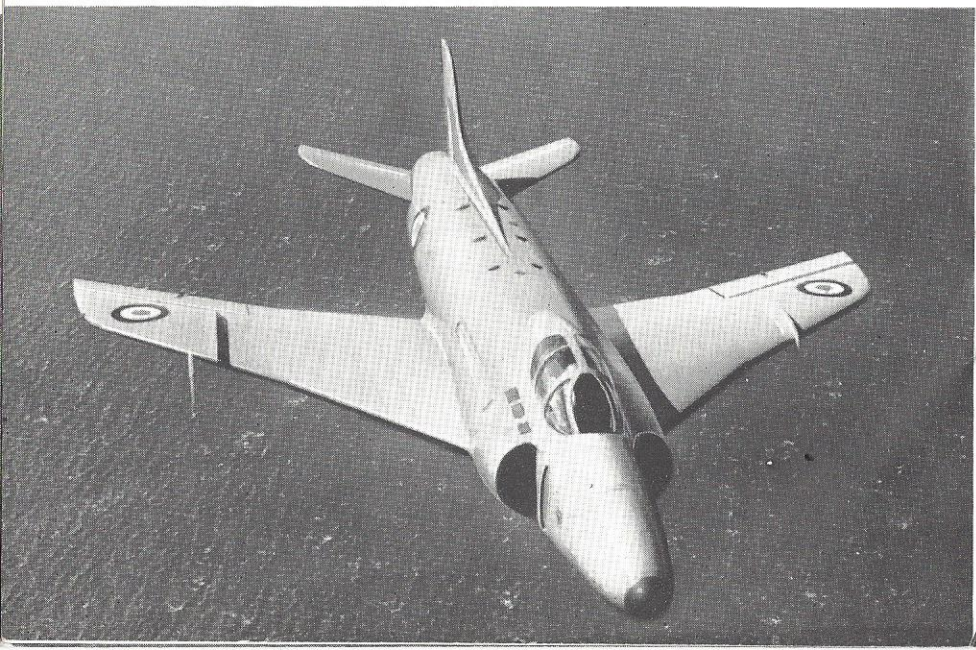




Vickers Supermarine Type 525 single-seat experimental carrier-borne naval fighter powered by two Rolls-Royce Avon jet engines

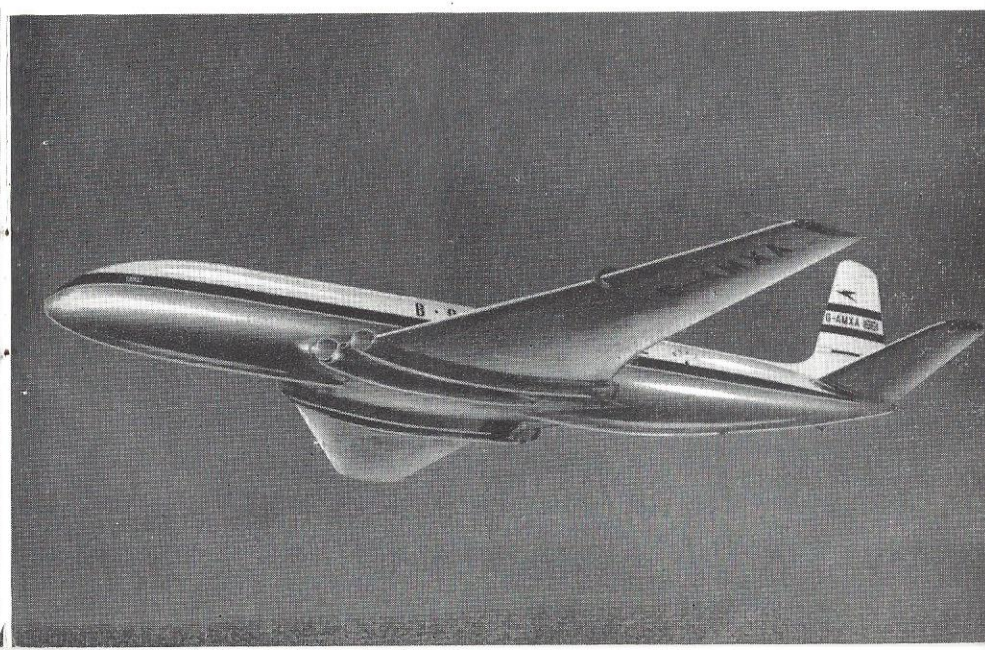
Vickers Supermarine Swift F.4 single-seat fighter powered by a Rolls-Royce Avon jet engine fitted with afterburner

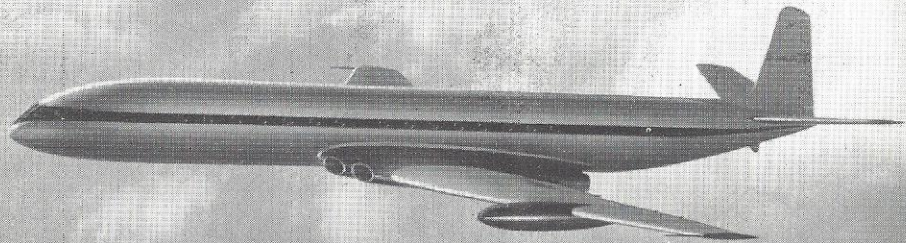


Vickers Valiant B.2 bomber powered by four Rolls-Royce Avon jet engines
