

**2015 83rd ENTRY REUNION
AT THE ROYAL BEACH HOTEL, SOUTHSEA / PORTSMOUTH**

There are several main transport routes to the Reunion Venue and good local transport for visiting the area:

By Car

From the north and west use the M27 and come off at Junction 12 (4 miles to hotel)

From the east use the A27

From the north and east use the A3

Approaching the outskirts of Portsmouth and Southsea look for signs to Seafront, Ferries, Old Portsmouth and Historic Waterfront.

Sat Nav is PO4 0RN. The hotel is opposite South Parade Pier.

By Air

You can fly into Southampton Airport about 20 miles from the hotel.

By Train

Gunwharf Quays is the destination for London main line trains from Waterloo.

By Bus / Coach

National bus routes from London.

Megabus runs from Birmingham to Portsmouth.

Buses also go to Brighton and Southampton.

By Sea Ferry

Hourly ferry to and from the ISLE of WIGHT. For Osbourn house and other points of interest.

Twice daily ferry from France, if you now reside there.

Also twice weekly ferry from Spain.

LOCAL BUS ROUTES START OUTSIDE THE ROYAL BEACH HOTEL AND RUN EVERY 10 MINUTES AND WILL TAKE YOU TO ALL THE MAJOR ATTRACTIONS IN CITY of PORTSMOUTH

BUS Route No: 1 - Gunwharf Quays - City Centre - Eastney - Southsea – Gunwharf Quays (Via Fratton - Milton - South Parade Pier - Old Portsmouth). ***This is the main route for the Historic Dock Yard.***

BUS Route No: 7 - Southsea - Portsmouth City Centre

BUS Route No: 23 - Southsea - Portsmouth City Centre

Attraction Opening Times and rates and transport connections:

- The Historic Dock Yard for HMS Victory, HMS Warrior, Mary Rose, etc. (open 10 am – 6 pm / senior All-Attractions ticket rate = £26.00 per ticket)

Important Note: Portsmouth Historic Dockyard's annual ALL-ATTRACTION TICKET now includes entry to the **Royal Navy Submarine Museum and HMS Alliance**, along with admission to **the Explosion, The Museum of Naval Firepower** and a **complimentary waterbus** to these attractions, as well as entry to the **Royal Marines Museum**. Visitors also have access to the **new Mary Rose Museum** and world famous ships **HMS Victory** and **HMS Warrior 1860**, plus many more exciting attractions.

- Gunwharf Quays Shopping Centre and Restaurants (open 10 am – 8 pm Mon to Sat, 7pm Sun)
- The Spinnaker Tower (open 10 am – 6 pm / senior ticket rate = £7.55 per ticket)
- Royal Marines Museum, Eastney Esplanade, Southsea (open 10 am – 5 pm / senior ticket rate = £7.00 per ticket)
- D-Day Museum (Overlord Embroidery is 272 feet long), Clarence Esplanade, Southsea (open 10 am – 5.30 pm / senior ticket rate = £5.70 per ticket)

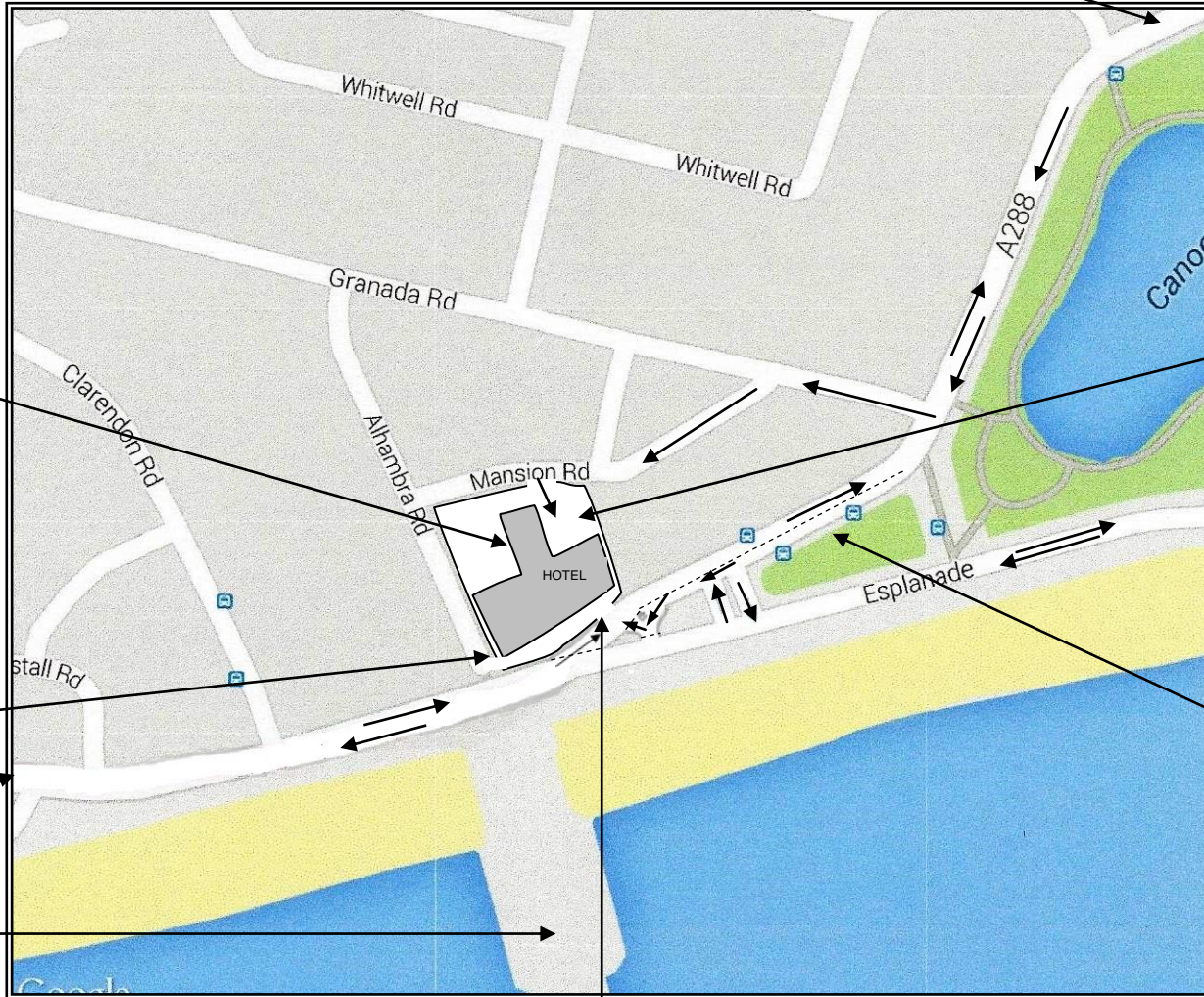
